FAMILY PREPAY LUNCH ACCOUNT & INCIDENTAL EXPENSES

With the end of the school year near, please check your family lunch account and incidental expenses balances.

Log into Family Portal (District Code: SVDP-IL)

"Prepay" section of your home page will indicate your family lunch account balance. Please be sure to add money to your lunch account to cover all lunch costs.

"Balances" section of your home page will indicate not only your payment plan for tuition/fees but also the Incidental Expenses owed. All billing for athletics, field trips, clubs/organizations, Care, etc. is done in FACTS and will show in the incidental expenses box. Please be sure to pay any incidental expenses balances promptly.

Adult and high school volunteers are needed for check in/out, kitchen crew, classroom help and other areas.


