#### **FREE & REDUCED LUNCH**

## **NWEA MAP GROWTH**

Fall Testing Dates: August 18th - September 5th

All students will complete NWEA MAPS Testing during our Fall testing window. Taken three times a year, MAP Growth is an assessment for measuring achievement and growth in K-12 math, reading, language usage, and science. It provides teachers with accurate, actionable evidence to help inform instructional



strategies regardless of how far students are above or below grade level. These tests assist teachers in planning individualized instruction. It also empowers our school staff as they continue to work to improve all educational outcomes. Individual results will be shared at our October conferences. Please be sure your children get plenty of sleep and have a good breakfast.

## **FACTS SIS - STUDENT ACCOUNT**

SVdP students can create their own Student Account in the Family Portal of our FACTS School Information System (SIS)! In this account, students will be able to access their grades, missing assignments, behavior, etc. Students will not have access to any financial information or lunch orders.

To create a student account:

- e click on FACTS Family Portal
- e click on Log in to Family Portal
- e click on Create New Family Portal Account
- ⊒. type in District Code: SVDP-IL



An email will be sent to the students' email address with instructions for creating a password. Students should use their email address as their username.

Once the student account is set up, students will need to make sure that they choose student in the Family Portal Log In screen.
